Pursuant to Article 64, paragraph 1, item b), Article 70, paragraphs 1, 3 and 6 of the Law on Public Procurement of Bosnia and Herzegovina ("Official Gazette of BiH", No 39/14), and Article 56 of the Company Statute and on the basis of the Response to the Request for opinion number: 11-49-1730-1/17 of October 17th, 2017 by the Federal Ministry of Transport and Communications and following the Recommendation of the Appointed committee members No. 01-366/2017- 8 of October 9th, 2017, in a competitive bid for public procurement of Climb Angle Audit in the outgoing procedure at LQMO, initiated at the request of the Sector of Traffic and Safety, Director of the Public Enterprise "Mostar International Airport" Ltd. takes

DECISION
on the selection of the bidder

Article 1.

The Recommendation of appointed committee members, No. 01-366/2017-8 of October 9th, 2017 is acknowledged and the Contract for Climb Angle Audit in the LQMO outgoing procedure is hereby awarded to the bidder "PildoLabs", headquartered in Barcelona, Spain, for the offered price of €5.178,00, or 10.142,66 KM, without VAT, as the best rated bidder.

Article 2.

The procurement contract proposal will be submitted to the selected bidder for signature within ten days from the date of receipt of this Decision.

The subject service will be implemented at the headquarters of the bidder in the Kingdom of Spain.

Upon execution of the contractual obligations, the bidder will submit the design procedures to the client within the deadline and in the manner defined by the contract, which will be a record of the quantitative and qualitative execution of the service.

The minutes must be signed and certified by the authorized representatives of the Contracting Parties.

The concerned service will be deemed to have been completed after the design of the procedure has been confirmed by the Directorate for Civil Aviation of Bosnia and Herzegovina (BHDCA) in the procedure defined by the Law on Aviation of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

On the day of the confirmation of the procedure by the Directorate for Civil Aviation of Bosnia and Herzegovina (BHDCA), payment deadlines will commence as defined in the draft contract as a constituent part of the tender documentation.

Upon the validity of this Decision, a contract on the realization of the concerned procurement will be concluded.

Article 3.

The execution of this Decision shall be entrusted to and authorized by the Sector of Economic - Financial, Administrative - Legal, General and Human affairs.

Article 4.

This Decision will be published on the website of Mostar Airport Ltd. at the same time as referring to the tenderers participating in the public procurement procedure, in accordance with Article 70, paragraph 6 of the Law on Public Procurement of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Article 5.

This Decision shall enter into force on the date of its adoption and shall be delivered to all tenderers who have participated in the public procurement procedure, in accordance with Article 71, paragraph 2 of the Law on Public Procurement of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Explanation

The Public Procurement Procedure was initiated by the Decision on the initiation of the Public Procurement Procedure No: 01-366/2017.

Public procurement was conducted through a competitive bidding request.

Estimated value of public procurement without VAT is 17.000,00 KM.

On October 9th, 2017 the committee members have submitted the Minutes of Review and Evaluation of the bids No: 01-366/2017-8 with the recommendation of the preferred bidder.

In the procedure under the Bid Evaluation Report it was established that the appointed public procurement members had timely and correctly performed the opening of the bids and the evaluation of the submitted bids, and a corresponding Minutes were prepared, which stated the following:

- that the total number of bids received is one;
- a timely receipt of the offer;
- that the company's "PildoLabs" offer is the only and qualified, and as such is first ranked.

In the process of adoption of this Decision, it is particularly appreciated that the appointed committee members, correctly and completely, gave the evaluation of the received tenders in accordance with the criteria of the request and the call.

By inspecting the enclosed documentation, it is indisputable that the selected bidder is best rated by taking into account the lowest price criteria.

For the above reasons, by applying Article 64, paragraph 1, item b). of the Law on Public Procurement of Bosnia and Herzegovina, it was decided as in the enacting clause.

INSTRUCTION OF LEGAL REMEDY

An appeal may be filed against this Decision, at the latest within 5 (five) days of receipt of this Decision, all in accordance with the Law on Public Procurement.
